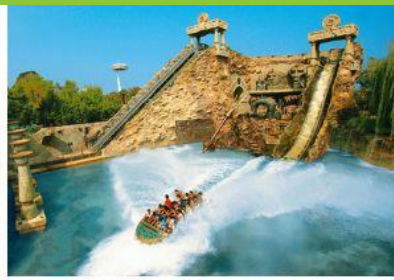

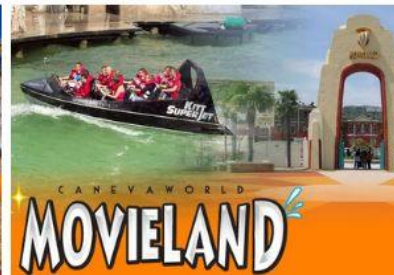

The aim of this guide is to help you choose the amusement park that best suits your needs from among those that are just a few minutes' drive from the Enjoy.

Use it as a good source of useful advice, but **always check on the official websites** of the parks for the most up-to-date conditions of entry and use of the rides, such as opening days, times, prices, gratuities and regulations.

Do you want to discover the best and most enjoyable attractions around Lake Garda? Our guide includes Gardaland, Legoland Water Park, Sea Life Aquarium, Movieland, Caneva and Parco Natura Viva.

# GARDALAND



Gardaland is the most famous amusement park in Italy, full of rides, shows and dining options.

During the year, there are **special openings**, such as in the evenings during the summer months, in the period around Halloween, and the magical Christmas openings that generally feature themed sets and shows.

## **Specially recommended**

For those who want to spend a whole day having fun, enjoying the rides and shows, and tasty, relaxing breaks. Gardaland is suitable for children, teenagers and adults.

# GARDALAND



## How to get a ticket

You can buy your ticket online or directly at the ticket office at the park. The online ticket price is slightly lower.

You can choose to visit only Gardaland or choose the **combo ticket** for Gardaland + Sea Life Aquarium or Gardaland + Legoland Waterpark. However, please read the conditions of entry to Legoland first as there are restrictions for adults and children under 2 years of age.

Other important information:

- If you are eligible, you can buy a **discount ticket**. It is valid for children under the age of 10, military personnel, the over 60s, self-sufficient disabled persons and the person accompanying a non-self-sufficient disabled person.

- **Children under 100 cm in height** and non-self-sufficient disabled persons **enter free of charge.**
- **Time-Saver ticket:** during very busy periods there may be long queues at the entrance to the rides, so in addition to the entrance ticket, you can buy a fast-track ticket called **Gardaland Express** (you will need one per person). There are different types, and you can buy them online, at the ticket office and at Gardaland Express Points.
- You can find more information on how to activate and use it on the official website.  
Keep in mind that there is a limited number of daily Time-Saver tickets so if you are interested you should buy them early before they run out.

## How to get there

Gardaland is only 2 km from the Enjoy. You can reach it by car in **5 minutes**, parking in the large **pay carpark**.

Alternatively, you can use the **free shuttle service** that leaves from the bus shelter located in front of Peschiera del Garda railway station, which is a 5-minute walk from the Enjoy. The bus runs every 30 minutes.

## Do you have a pet?

Pets **are allowed into Gardaland**, but not into the Legoland Water Park area. If you have a dog, you must keep it on a leash, and it must wear a muzzle if it is a large dog.

Pets are not allowed on the rides or in the shows, but they can accompany you to the restaurants, where there are special areas that enable you to stay with them.

## Other useful tips:

- Simplify your outing by using **the official amusement park App** to buy tickets and find the rides, shows, restaurants and shops faster with the GPS navigator. You will also find the schedule of all the day's shows and you can opt, if you wish, to receive a reminder before they start. In some cases, the information may out of date, so always check when you are on site.
- Keep in mind that **some rides open at different times**, so check the times of the ones you want to visit so as to avoid disappointment.
- You can **eat** at one of the many dining options. Remember that July and August are very busy months so you may have to wait longer than usual to be served.
- If you have special dietary needs, please note that you will find on-site directions to bars/restaurants that offer **gluten-free, vegetarian and child-friendly menus**.

## Other useful tips:

- **To save money** you can buy online vouchers to eat at some of the refreshment points: they cost less than buying food once you are inside the park.
- The quickest alternative is **to bring your own food and drink** but bear in mind that Gardaland offers only a small picnic area where you can have your meal.
- **Do you need to recharge your mobile phone?** No problem, you can recharge it free at the following places: Merlin Stube, Ristorante Aladino, Buffalo Ranch and Focacceria & Gelateria Kung Fu. You can also use the Gardaland-Guest **free Wi-Fi network**.
- There are **restrictions** on access to some rides based on height, age and health. The official website has an updated list of conditions explaining which rides you can access safely. There is also a special **guide for disabled persons**, which can be requested at the Welcome Desk at the entrance.

## Other useful tips:

- **If you have a child**, go to the 'Rides' section of the official website and select the height of your child: you will instantly be able to see which rides are accessible to your child.
- If you want to **leave and then return to the park** during the day, you must go to the entry/exit turnstiles and ask for the stamped 'pass'.
- **Special areas for small children:** Peppa Pig Land is for them, a fun area designed for their specific needs.
- Should you need **Nursery** facilities, you will find them in the Fantasy Kingdom area, whereas if you need a **stroller/buggy** you can rent one at the entrance or in the West village.
- Wear **comfortable shoes**.

# LEGOLAND



Legoland Water Park deserves a separate, dedicated section because it is located inside Gardaland but requires an additional ticket. It is a fully Lego-themed **water park dedicated to children aged 2 to 12 years**, where you will find slides, pools and play areas.

## **Specially recommended**

For children aged 2 to 12 years, who want to spend a few hours enjoying slides, water features and pools.

Be careful because there are specific entry rules to ensure maximum peace of mind for children: adults can enter only if they accompany a child aged under 12 years (maximum 2 adults per child). Boys and girls aged 13 to 17 can enter independently without a minder.

## How to get a ticket

To enter you have to buy the **combo ticket Gardaland + Legoland**. Alternatively, you can pay a **supplement** at the ticket office or inside Gardaland Park. Unfortunately, you cannot buy a ticket only for Legoland. **Children under 100 cm in height enter free of charge.**

## Do you have a pet?

Entry is not allowed to animals.

## Other useful tips

- Inside this small park you will find **free sun umbrellas and sunbeds** and, if you want, you can rent a locker to store your valuables, etc.
- If you **have children under 8 years of age** you can relax: the staff will equip them with a life jacket free of charge. It is mandatory up to that age.
- We would like to highlight **Miniland**, in particular: it is a to-scale reconstruction of the most famous Italian monuments created with the world's most beloved building bricks.

# GARDALAND SEALIFE AQUARIUM



The **first fully themed aquarium in Italy**, it has 40 tanks and about 5,000 forms of sea-life, ranging from freshwater lake fish to the creatures that inhabit our seas and oceans.

Among the major attractions is a stunning **transparent underwater tunnel**, where you feel surrounded by sharks, stingrays and other fish.

For the more inquisitive, there are **games and quizzes** to do in every room, making your tour even more entertaining and educational.

For toddlers and smaller kids there are low portholes, specially designed to enable them to view the marine habitats.

## **Specially recommended**

For those who love nature and in particular the aquatic world, but also for anyone with free time who wants to enjoy a fascinating experience, perhaps with the family.

It is suitable for children, teenagers and adults. The tour lasts about 90 minutes.

It may be an interesting option to come on a rainy day because the aquarium is completely covered.

## How to get a ticket

You can choose to buy an open **ticket for the aquarium only** or buy the **Gardaland + Sea Life Aquarium combo ticket**, which saves you money if you intend to visit both attractions.

Other important information:

- To save even more, you can buy your ticket online instead of at the ticket office. If you go with the whole family you can opt for a **Family ticket** (for 3, 4 or 5 people), but you can only do that at the ticket office.

- The **discount ticket** is valid for children under the age of 10, military personnel, the over 60s, self-sufficient disabled persons and the person accompanying a non-self-sufficient disabled person.
- **Children under 100 cm** in height and non-self-sufficient disabled persons enter **free of charge**.

## How to get there

Sea Life Aquarium is only 2 km from the Enjoy. You can get there by car in **5 minutes**, parking in the large **pay carpark**.

Alternatively, you can use the **free shuttle service** that leaves from the bus shelter located in front of Peschiera del Garda train station, which is a 5-minute walk from the Enjoy. The bus runs every 30 minutes.

If you are already at Gardaland, you can get to the aquarium via a short walk, or you can take the miniature train.

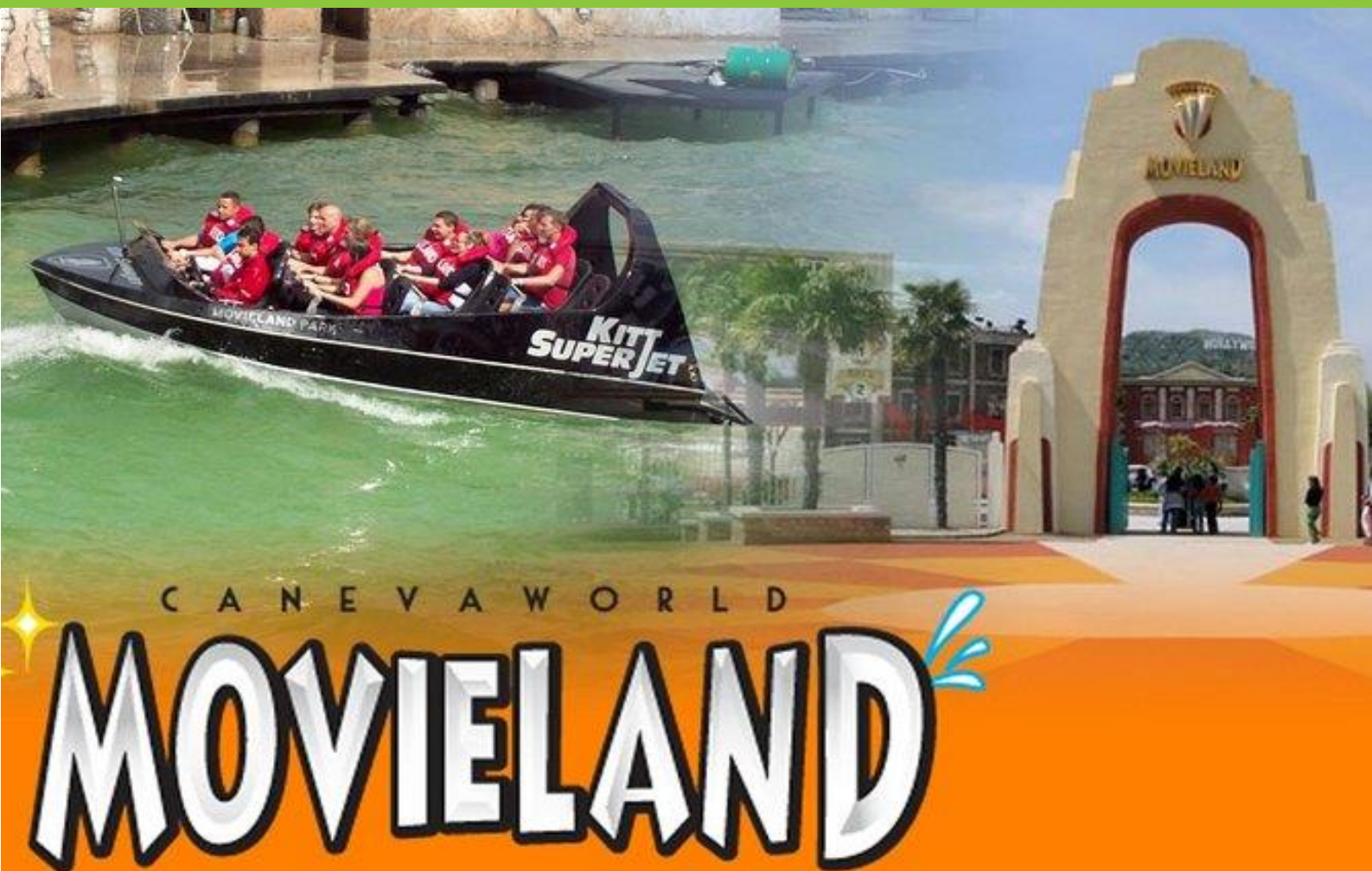
## Do you have a pet?

**Entry is not allowed to animals** inside the aquarium, with the exception of guide dogs for the blind.

## Other useful tips

- At the end of the tour there is a **bar and restaurant service** if you want to take a break. But if you like the idea of taking things easy, why not go to the area outside Sea Life? You will find a **green space equipped for picnics and a children's playground**.
- As the Sea Life passageways are not huge, **you will not be able to enter with strollers/buggies**. They must be left in the external, unattended covered storage area. Exceptions are strollers/buggies for disabled children.

# MOVIELAND



Movieland and Caneva are part of the same organization. They are located next to each other and have separate entrances and tickets.

Movieland is an amusement park where you can find more than 20 rides and several impressive shows **based on the world of cinema.**

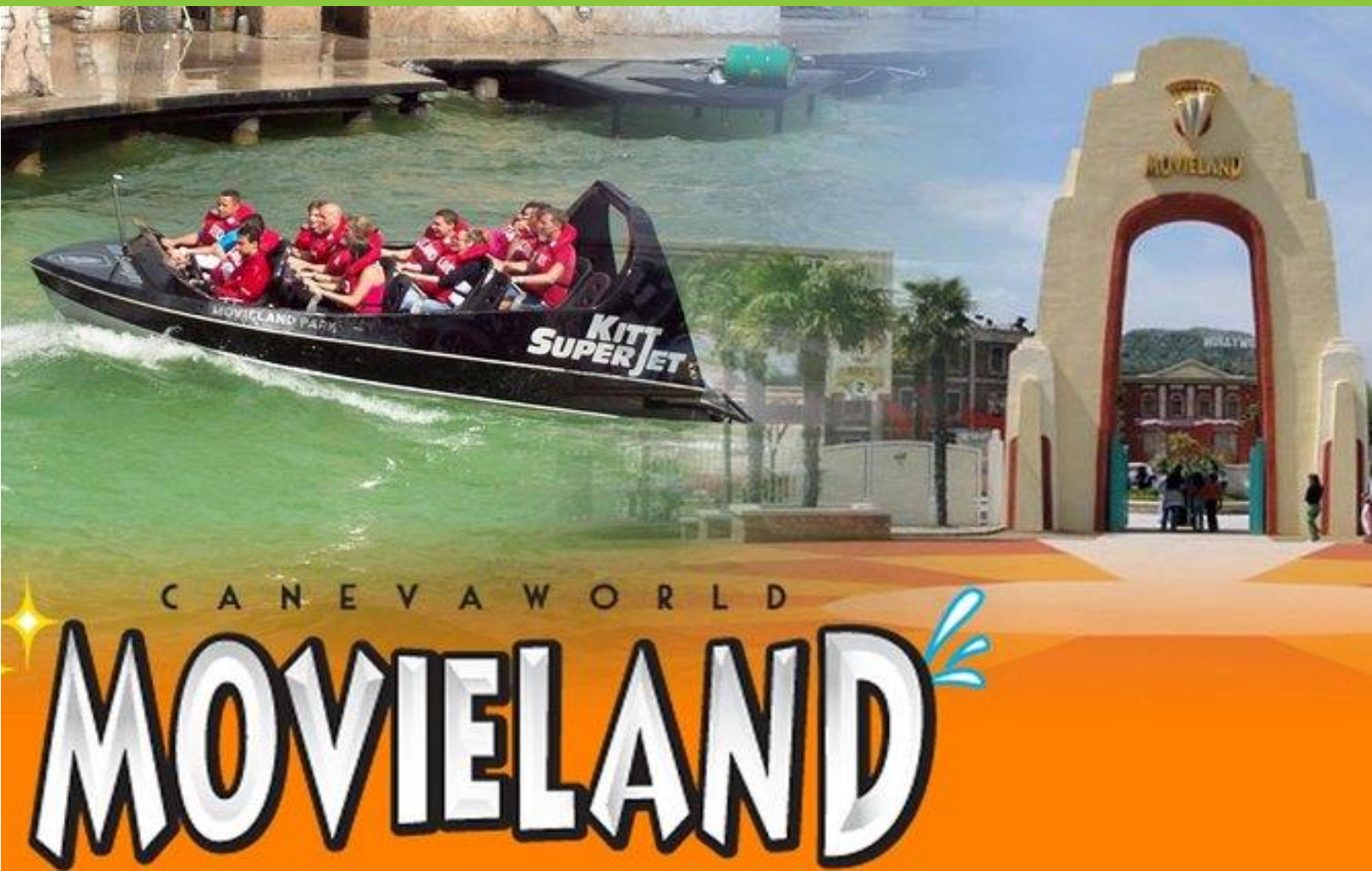

## How to get a ticket

You can buy tickets directly at the ticket office or online on the official website <https://www.canevaworld.it/>. Generally, these are open-date tickets that you can use when you want during the current season. However, always check their validity on the site when you buy them.

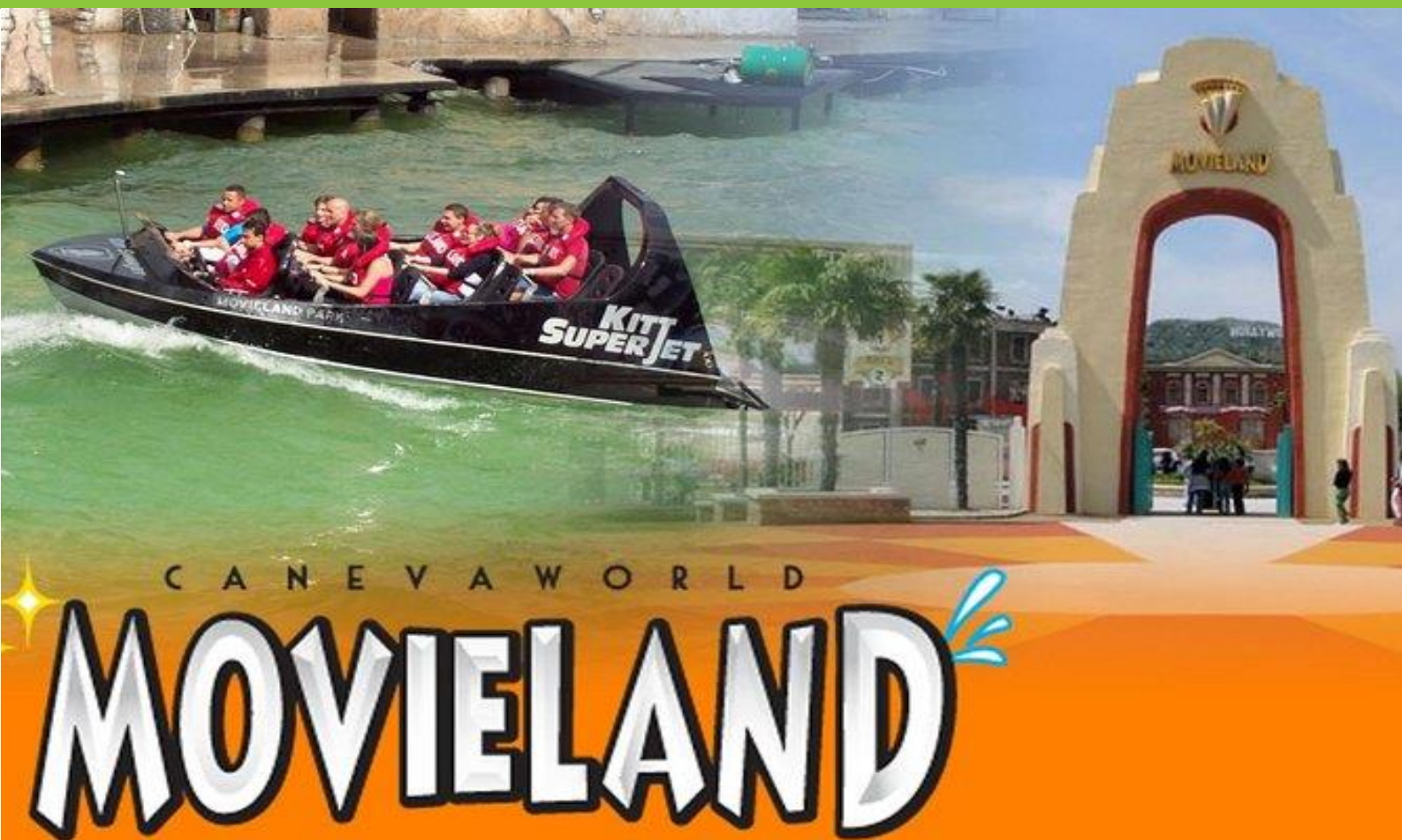

Other important information:

- **On your birthday, you can enter free of charge** by showing a valid identity document at the ticket office.
- If you want to buy a **discount ticket** for disabled persons, pregnant women, the over 65s and law enforcement/armed forces personnel, you can only do that at the ticket office.
- There is a **Movieland + Caneva combo ticket**, which is cheaper than buying two separate tickets. You can choose a ticket that is valid for one or more days to suit your needs.
- In the middle of the summer season, evening tickets are also available **at a discounted price**.
- **Do you have children?** Those under 100 cm in height enter free of charge.

# MOVIELAND



## How to get there

Movieland is 5 km from the Enjoy, next to Caneva Aquapark. You can get there comfortably by car in **7 minutes**, parking in a large **pay carpark** that is located in front of the amusement park.

Alternatively, during the park's open season, there is a **free shuttle service** that leaves from outside the exit of Peschiera del Garda railway station, a few minutes' walk from the Enjoy. Check the schedules online on the official website.

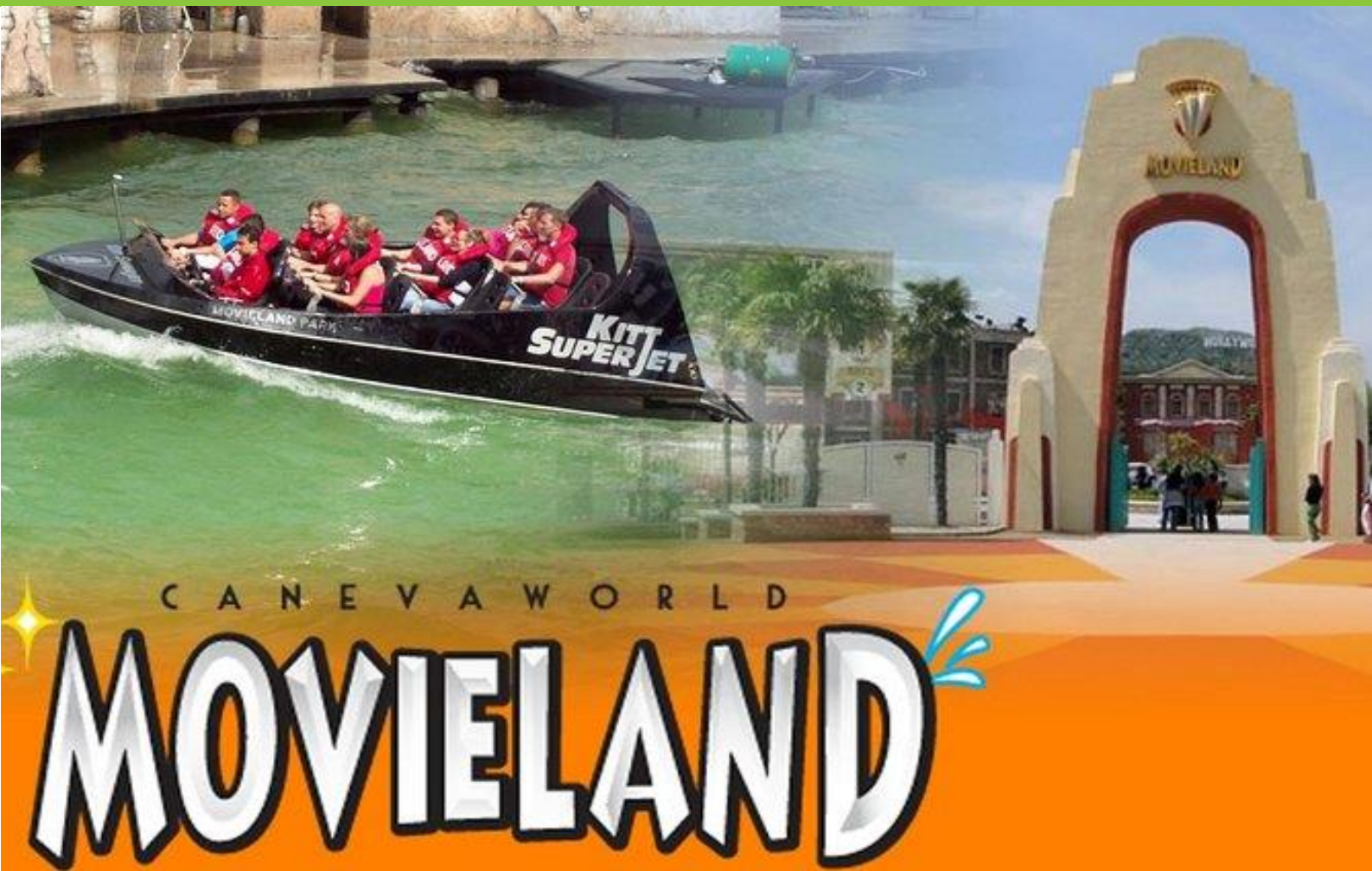
## Do you have a pet?

Dogs are allowed but must be registered at the Infopoint before entry. They must also always be kept on a leash and if they are medium or large in size, they must wear a muzzle. They are not allowed on the rides or in the movie theatre.

## Specially recommended

For those who love cinema and want to spend the day in a more easy-going amusement park. In fact, Movieland is smaller and much less crowded than Gardaland. It is suitable for children, teenagers and adults.

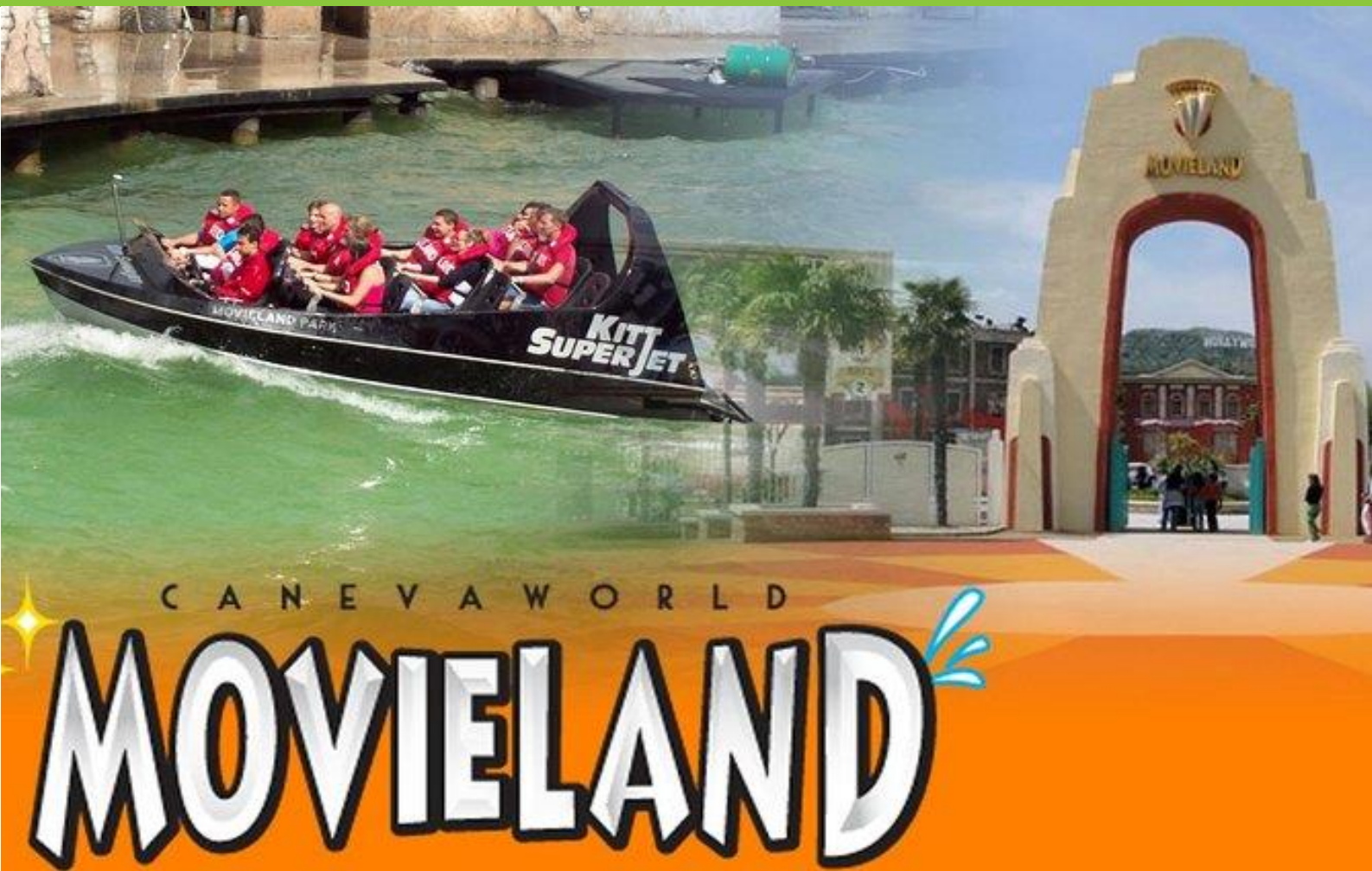

## Other useful tips

- During the day **you can go out and return to the Park**, but before doing so you must ask the attendant to give you a rubber-stamped 'pass'. Upon return, you will need to show your 'pass' and entrance ticket.
- Bear in mind that during busy periods, a queue may build up to access some particularly popular rides such as **Pangea**. We would therefore advise you to go there right away and take advantage of a quiet moment before it gets too busy.
- **You can view the times of the shows on the led walls** (digital screens) that are located inside the park. Be careful because some particularly popular shows only **have a few reruns** and, in some cases, only run in the evenings.
- On sunny days you may need to use **sunscreen lotion** because many areas are exposed to the sun. Luckily, there are fountains and water nebulizers in the park so you can cool off.

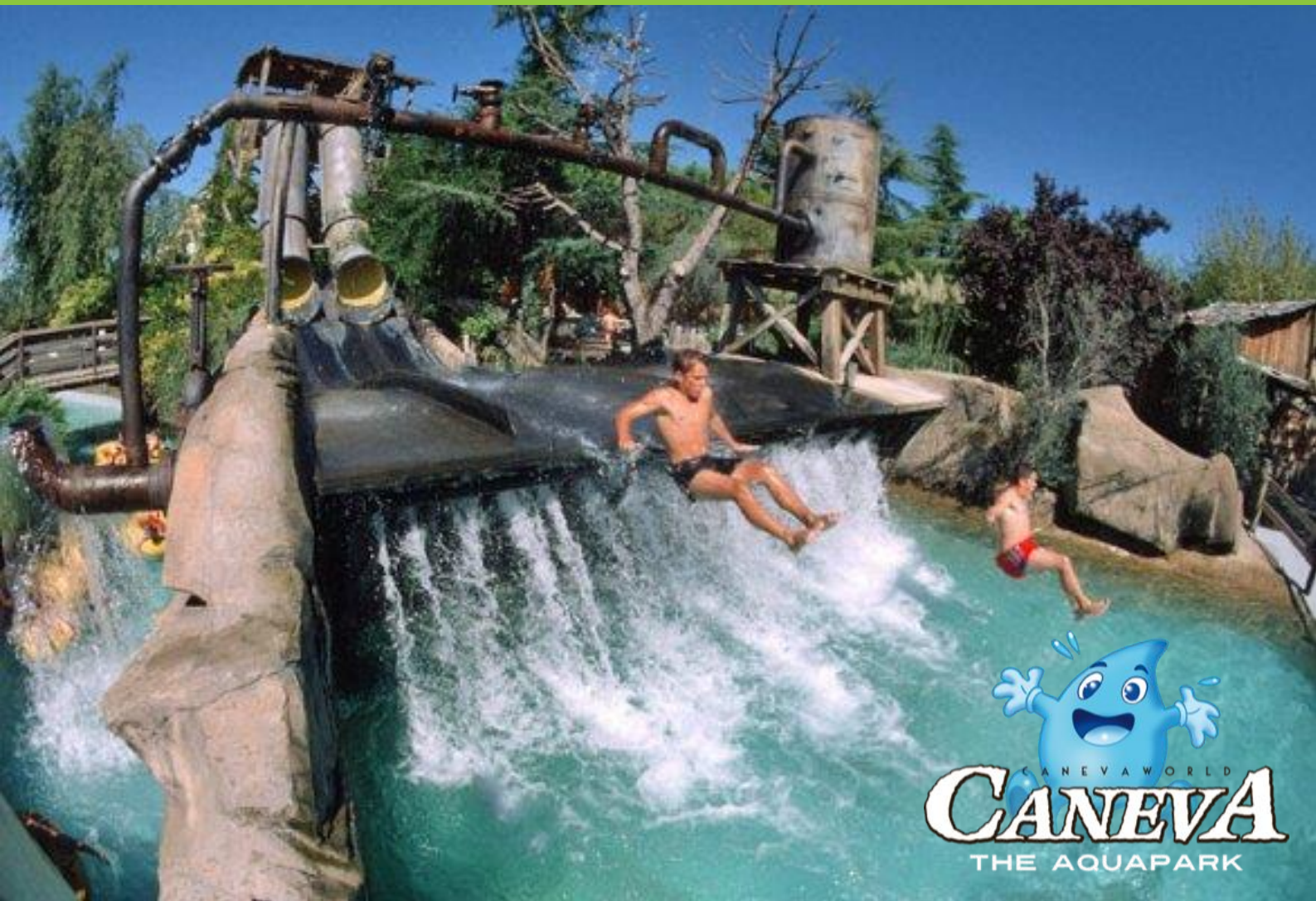

## Other useful tips

- On occasion, **some rides are closed before the park's closing time**, so we recommend that you go immediately to those you don't want to miss.
- You will find several **dining options** where you can eat in peace, **as well as picnic spots** and shady areas.
- We advise **you to dress comfortably** and bear in mind that some rides will involve contact with water, so **you may get wet**. If you are interested, you can buy disposable raincoats before starting on your series of rides.
- If you want to stay for **dinner**, at the Movieland exit there are 3 very special restaurants (Safari Pizza, Medieval Times Restaurant & Show, Rock Star Restaurant), but remember that **you must book in advance**.

Movieland and Caneva are part of the same organization. They are located next to each other and have separate entrances and tickets.

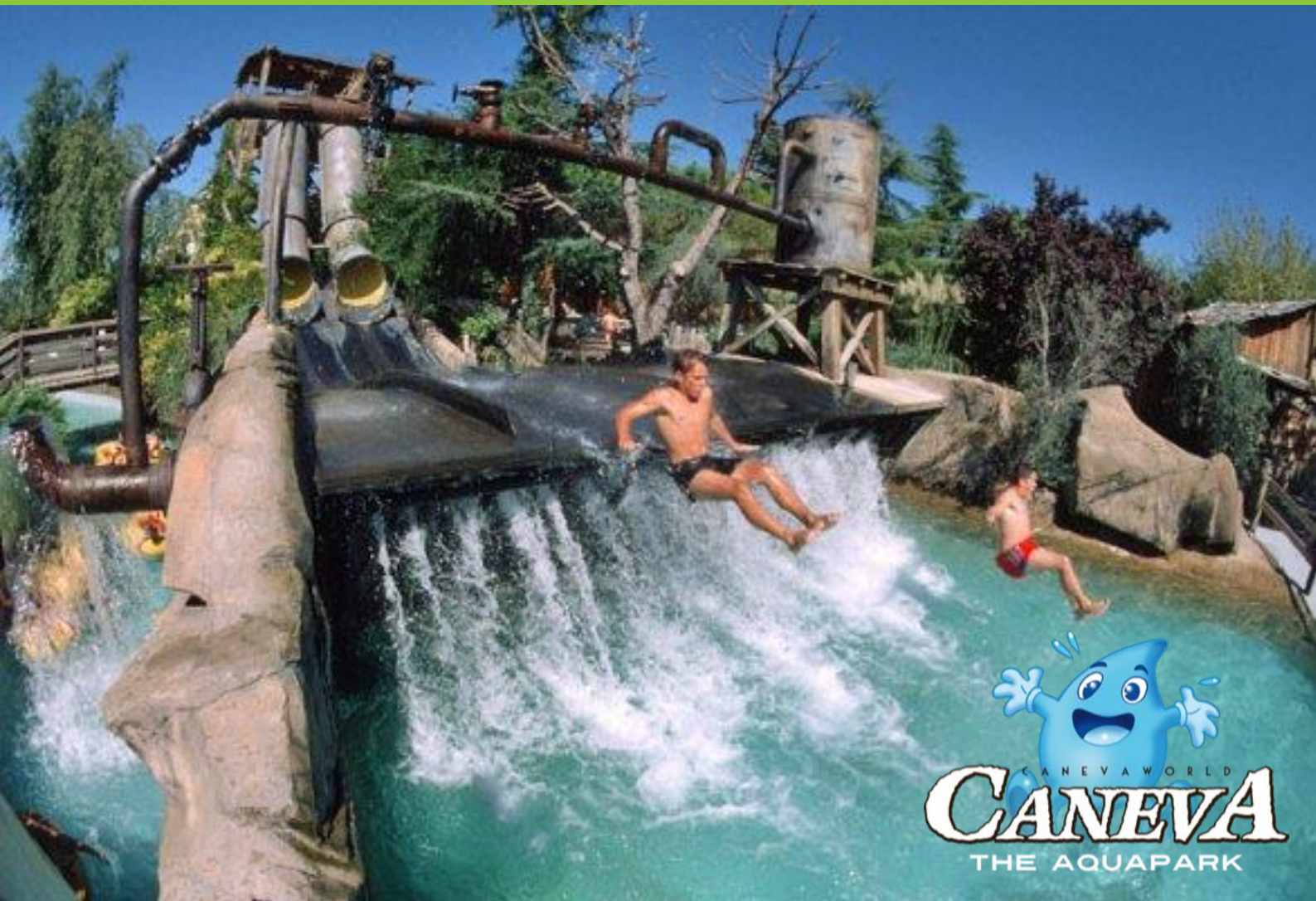
Caneva Aquapark **is a Caribbean-themed water amusement park** with slides, swimming pools, water features and relaxation areas where you can spend the whole day.

## **Specially recommended**

For those who want to spend a day in the sun and in the water, having fun on adrenalin-pumping rides such as Stukas and Twin Peaks.

Caneva is not particularly suitable for those seeking peace and relaxation unless you book **private areas** such as Malibu Beach and Cabanas Club that guarantee more peace and quiet and a reserved place to spend the day. It is suitable for children, teenagers and adults.

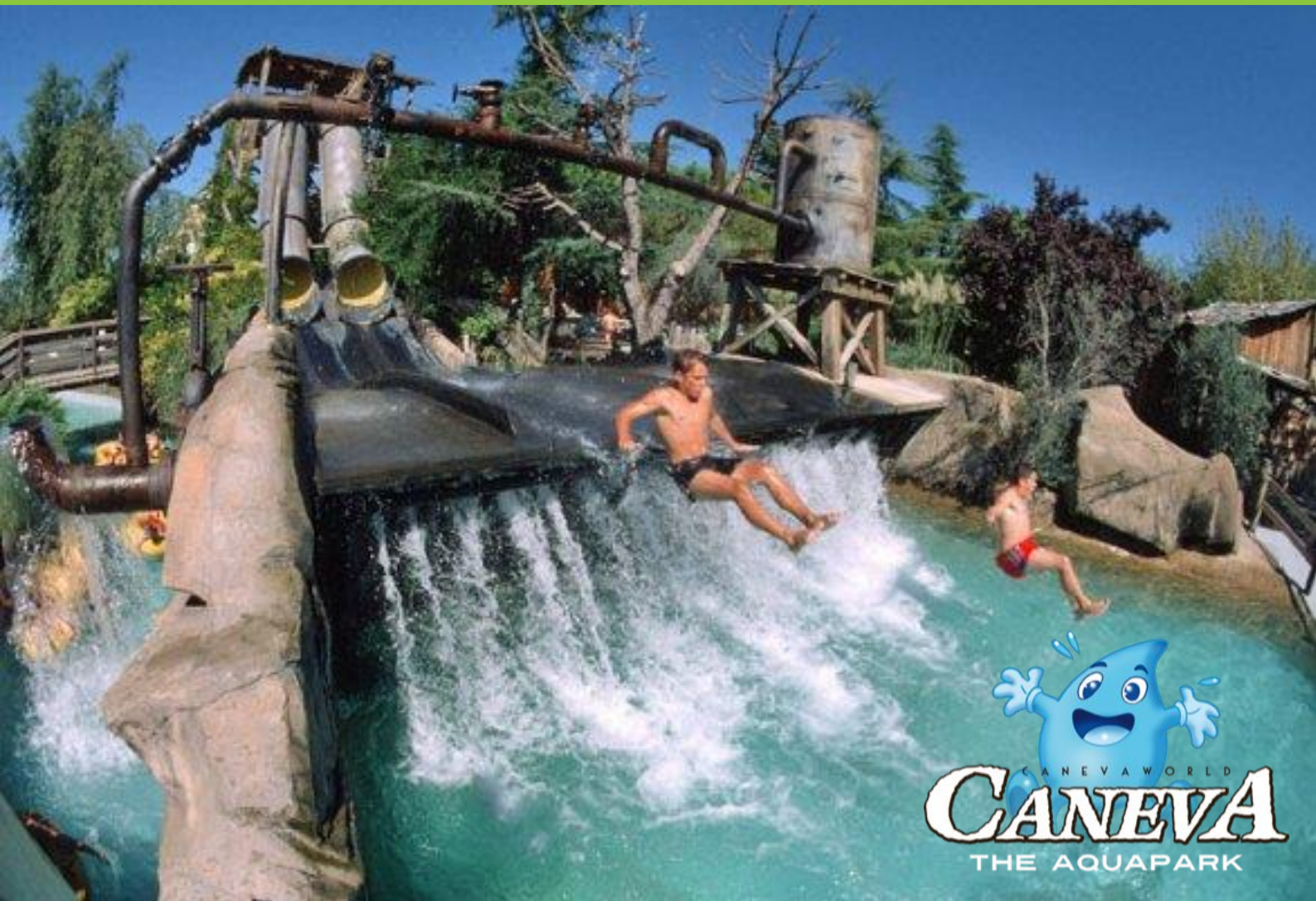

## How to get a ticket

Generally, these are open-date tickets, which you can use when you want during the current season. However, always check their validity on the site when you buy.

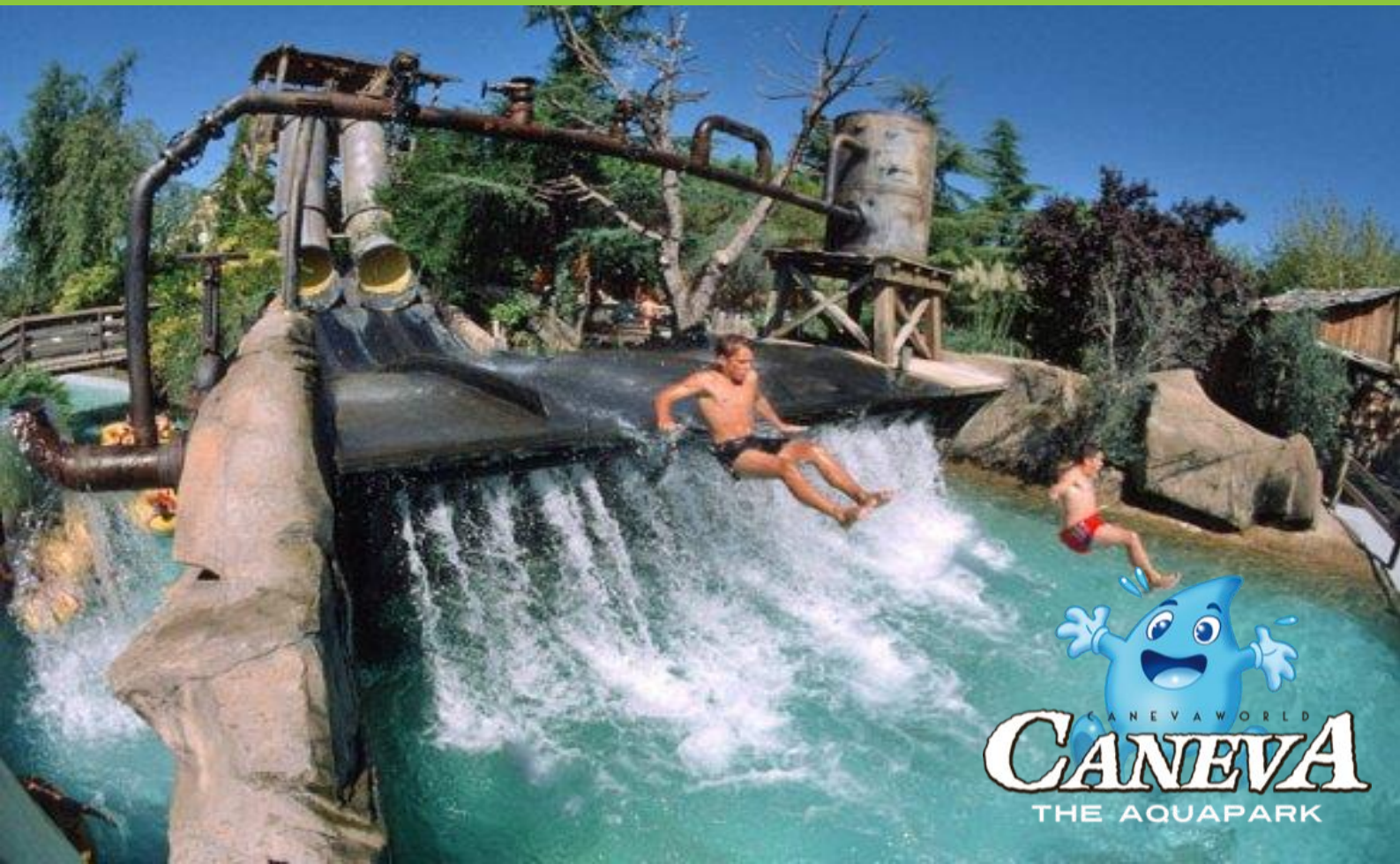

Other important information:

- **On your birthday you can enter free of charge** by showing a valid identity document at the ticket office.
- If you want to buy a **discount ticket** for disabled persons, pregnant women, over 65s and law enforcement/armed forces personnel, you can only do that at the ticket office.
- There is a **Caneva + Movieland combo ticket** which allows you to save money compared with buying two separate tickets. You can choose a ticket that is valid for one or more days, to suit your preferences.
- **Do you have children?** Those under 100 cm in height enter free of charge.

## How to get there

Caneva Aquapark is 5 km from the Enjoy, next to Movieland. You can get to it by car in **7 minutes**, parking in the large **pay carpark** located in front of the amusement park.

Alternatively, during the park's opening period, there is a **free shuttle service** that leaves from outside the exit of Peschiera del Garda railway station, a 5-minute walk from the Enjoy. Check the schedules online on the official website.

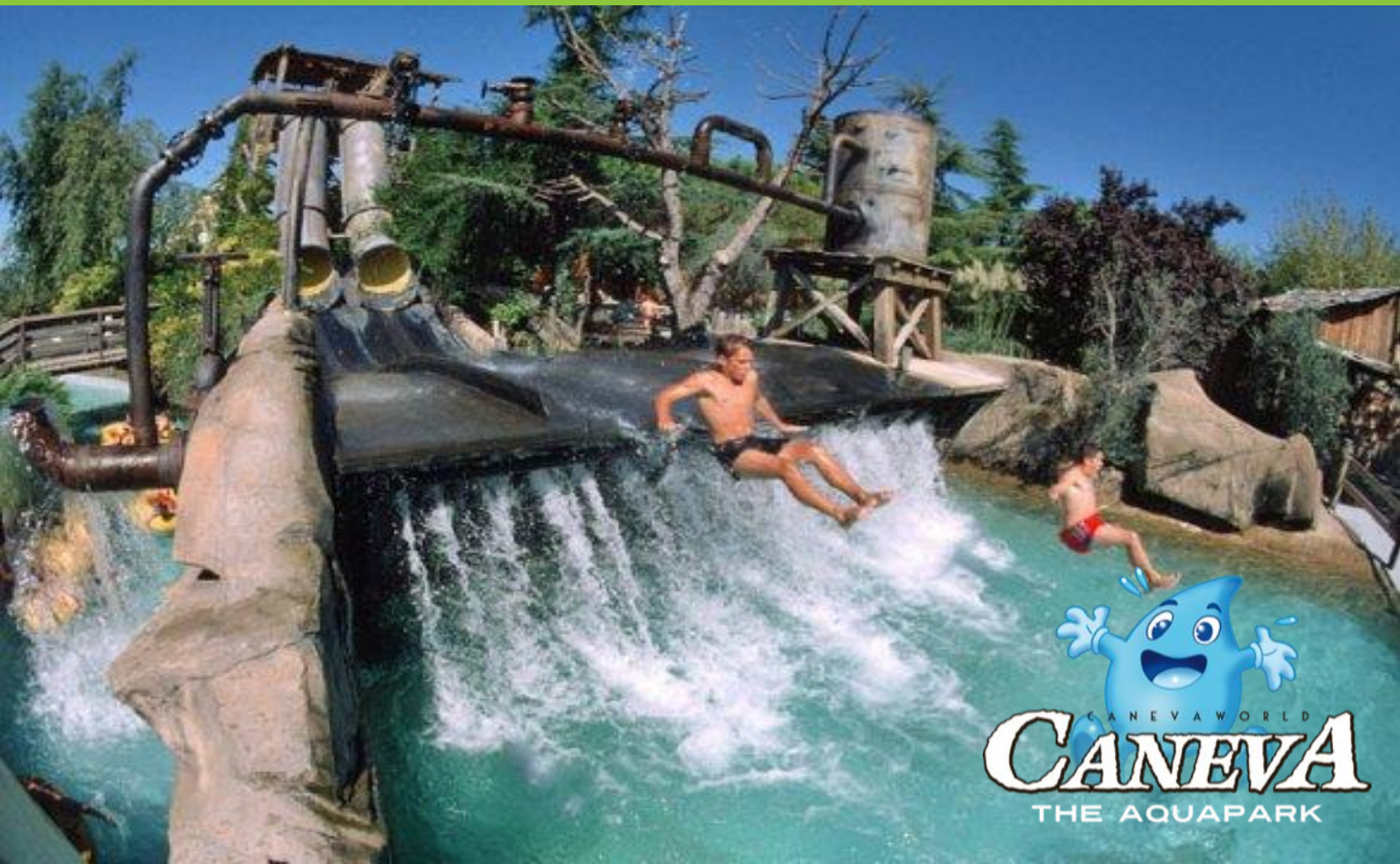
## Do you have a pet?

Dogs **are not allowed** into Caneva Aquapark for hygiene reasons.

## Other useful tips:

- **You cannot access the rides with slippers, flip-flops, cameras, glasses** (both sunglasses and prescription glasses), **face masks and mobile phones**, so you must temporarily hand them over to someone you trust or store them in the special **pay locker** that you will find at the entrance. Be careful, because sometimes the availability of lockers falls short of the number of people who want to use them, so we advise you to book one as soon as you arrive if you think you will need it.

- **Deckchairs and umbrellas are limited**, so we recommend that you arrive at the park at opening time to ensure you find a comfortable place to lay down your towel. Alternatively, you can **book a place at a private beach** such as Malibu Beach and Cabanas Club, which offer a quieter area and a range of amenities included in the price. Check on the website to see all the advantages of these exclusive reserved areas that can be booked throughout the day.
- Before getting on the rides **always check what is written on the entrance signs**. You must be in good health and not suffer from hypertension, heart or spinal problems, or motion sickness. You must not have prostheses or disabilities and you must comply with other standards, such as minimum height. If you are pregnant some rides may be unsuitable or prohibited.
- **Younger children** can go to Windy Lagoon, an area specially designed for them with 9 slides, games and water jets.
- If you want to stay for **dinner**, at the Movieland exit there are 3 very special restaurants (Safari Pizza, Medieval Times Restaurant & Show, Rock Star Restaurant), which **you must book in advance**.

Parco Natura Viva is a **large zoological park that houses 1500 animals** on an area of 42 hectares of lush, wooded greenery.

It is divided into two sections, with separate access to each. You can choose to start visiting the section you prefer, but we advise you to start with the Safari Park, because in the afternoon it closes earlier than the Fauna section (zoo). This way, once you have finished your car ride through the Safari Park, you will have much more time to enjoy the experience of walking through the Fauna Park.

The **Fauna Park** is the largest part of the park, housing 90% of the animals. You can walk for about 5 km admiring species from all over the world such as the European bison, the alpaca, the lesser panda, the oriental grey kangaroo, the Bactrian camel and the snowy owl.

The duration of the tour is variable, but we advise you to spend at least 4-5 hours there.

The **Safari Park** is approximately a 2-km stretch that can be covered at a walking pace in your own car, with no chance to stop or get out of your vehicle. Here you can admire African animals such as antelopes, giraffes, lions, Watussi oxen, cheetahs, wildebeest and some very nice lemurs.

The tour lasts about 40 minutes, and it is quite normal for queues to form at the entrance. If you do not have a car, you can rent one of the Park's Jeeps, booking it in advance by email.

## **Specially recommended**

For those who want to immerse themselves in nature and love long walks. Since the park has several sections that go uphill it could be tiring or problematic for anyone pushing a stroller/buggy or for those who have difficulty walking. The Park is suitable for children, teenagers and adults.

## **How to get a ticket**

There is a single entrance ticket to Parco Natura Viva that entitles you to access both the Fauna Park (zoo) and the Safari Park.

It can be bought online on the official website <https://www.parconaturaviva.it> or directly upon arrival at one of the park's ticket offices.

Additional important information:

- **If you buy your ticket online, you have the right to fast-tracked entrance to the Fauna Park, avoiding the queues.** Keep in mind, however, that the discount tickets for disabled persons and for the over 65s can only be requested at the ticket office.
- We advise you to visit the 'Discounts' and 'Discounts and Promo' pages on the site, because at certain times of the year, **there are discounts on the entrance price.**
- You can choose between **a fixed-date ticket and a variable-date ticket.** If you buy the fixed-date ticket and then for whatever reason you are unable to go, you will not receive any refund or change of date.
- **Do you have children?** Those up to 5 years old enter free of charge.
- We can highlight an interesting option: **if your child is between 5 and 12 years old** you can buy an additional ticket to participate in one of the **educational workshops**, divided by age groups. Look for the various options in the online 'Tickets' section.

During the summer, the park also **organizes evening events** that can include walks, dinners and shows. If you are interested in a rather unusual experience, in a less crowded environment, look for the events on the official website.

## How to get there

The park is a **15-minute** drive from the Enjoy.

Parking P1 is free, but is reserved for subscribers, disabled persons, bikes and buses. The P2, P3 and P4 car parks are dedicated to all other visitors who arrive by motorbike, car and camper and are **subject to charges**.

There are no buses that connect Peschiera del Garda to Parco Natura Viva.

## Do you have a pet?

- In the **Fauna Park (zoo) section**, dogs and pets are prohibited. The only alternative is to place them in a kennel in the dog area, which is located near the entrance to carpark P1.
- In the **Safari Park** section, you are allowed to have your animals inside your car, but only if kept in the appropriate 'pet carrier' required by current legislation.

## Other useful tips

- Wear **comfortable shoes**.
- Weekends are the busiest time, especially between 10:00 - 13:00. If you can, we advise you to **choose a weekday**. If you can only go on a Saturday or Sunday, try to arrive by 09:00 or in the early afternoon.
- Always check the times of the Safari Park, so as not to arrive too near to closing time. Keep in mind that in the busiest periods, you will have to queue to enter this section.
- **Do you want to save on admission?** Buy a fixed-date ticket for a weekday: they cost less than weekends, holidays or variable-date tickets.
- Inside the park you will find several **dining options, bathrooms and play areas** for children.

There are also several outdoor picnic areas, so if you intend to bring a packed lunch, it's a good idea to check the weather forecast in advance.
